REGISTRATION

This year the NBS will be offering two types of Registration, a Registration for Skiers and a Registration for First Time/Non Skiers. **PLEASE NOTE: NBS registration packages are only available to NBS participants staying in NBS housing or certified timeshares.**

THE BRECK35 (REGISTRATION) PASS INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING NBS BENEFITS:

- All Breck35 passes entitle participants to a special 35th anniversary gift and access to enter all of the NBS activities and events, including, exclusive happy hours, parties, the picnic on the hill and many more events to come.
- The Breck35 pass is also a personal activity pass that entitles participants to discounts at bars, restaurants, rental shops and retail shops both on the mountain of Breckenridge and in the vibrant ski town just steps from the base of the mountain.
- A special discount booklet will be provided to registered participants. The book provides discounts around Breckenridge for restaurants, retail shops and activities. Window signs for each participating business will be shown and NBS participants can only receive the appropriate discounts with the Breck35 pass.

The Breck35 (Registration) Pass for Alpine/Downhill Skiers includes all NBS registration benefits **plus** up to 5 days at any of the following five mountains: Breckenridge, Arapahoe Basin, Keystone, Vail and Beaver Creek. *Normal Lift Ticket costs at Breckenridge, Keystone and Arapahoe Basin are \$81 per day and \$89 per day at both Vail and Beaver Creek*

The Breck35 (Registration) Pass for Nordic Skiers includes all NBS registration benefits **plus** up to five (5) days of Nordic skiing. There are 2 Nordic Centers in Breckenridge. Breckenridge Nordic Center located at 1200 Ski Hill Road and Gold Run Nordic Center located on Tiger Road by the golf course. Passes are also good at the Frisco Nordic Center.

The Breck35 (Registration) Pass for Non-skiers/First Time Skiers. A limited number of Breck35 (Registration) passes for Non-Skiers/First Time Skiers will be available. This pass includes all NBS registration benefits **plus** an opportunity to try skiing for the first time – one free beginner lesson and lift ticket

CONTACT TRIP LEADER REGARDING THE FOLLOWING:

The Mini-Breck35 (Registration) Pass will entitle participants to NBS registration benefits including a special 35th Anniversary gift, access to all NBS exclusive happy hours, evening parties, etc. for a three (3) day period. The individual must select the registration to cover events and activities for the three-day period of January 12-15 or January 15-18, 2008) There is one price for the Mini-Breck35 or Midweek Registration (\$335) regardless of when it is paid.

Youth Breck35 pass (age 5-12): \$177; (age 13-18): \$270

There is one price for Youth Registration regardless of when it is paid. The Breck35 Youth Pass includes registration for the 2008 AMCC, which will entitle participants to a special 35th Anniversary gift, and access to all youth activities – AND - **Up to five (5) days of skiing at Breckenridge, Keystone, A-Basin, Vail and Beaver Creek**

WINTER FOX MINI-SUMMIT/AMCC PACKAGES

Winter Fox Mini-Summit/AMCC packages are now open with payment plans. Registration includes a \$20 WFSA Administrative Fee (♦). WFSA is still negotiating lodging arrangements and projects that accommodations for 7-days in a hotel room (dbl. occ) or a 2-bedroom condo for 4 people, will range from \$700 -\$750 (*) per person. We are collecting the higher amount and will refund the difference when the exact prices are established.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ABOUT BRECKENRIDGE 2008

WHAT IS THE BRECK35 (REGISTRATION) PASS?

A registration pass for the 2008 AMCC.

WHAT DO I GET FOR THE BRECK35 PASS?

All Breck35 passes entitle participants to enter all of the NBS activities and events, including, happy hours, parties, and picnic on the hill. It also entitles you to a special 35th anniversary gift. Additionally, the Skier Breck35 pass allows you to ski up to 5 days at any of the following five mountains: Breckenridge, Arapahoe Basis, Keystone, Vail and Beaver Creek.

The Breck35 pass is also a personal activity pass that entitles you to discounts at bars, restaurants, rental shops and retail shops both on the mountain of Breckenridge and in the vibrant ski town just steps from the base of the mountain.

WILL THE PERSONAL ACTIVITY PASS BE HONORED AT ALL BARS, RESTAURANTS, RENTAL SHOPS, AND RETAIL SHOPS?

A special discount booklet will be provided to registered participants. The book provides discounts around Breckenridge for restaurants, retail shops and activities. Window signs for each participating business will be shown and NBS participants can only receive the appropriate discounts with the Breck35 pass.

WILL INDIVIDUALS BE ABLE TO CHANGE FROM A NON-SKIER TO A SKIER REGISTRATION – OR - FROM A SKIER TO A NON-SKIERS REGISTRATION?

Yes, if any are available. However, there will be **no** Mid or 1/2 week pass for non-skiers.

CAN HOLDERS OF THE NON-SKIER/FIRST TIME SKIER PASS PURCHASE ADDITIONAL LIFT TICKETS AT A DISCOUNT?

Holders of the non-skier/first time skier pass **cannot** purchase additional lift tickers at a discount however, they can upgrade to the Breck35 skier pass for \$155.

WILL THERE BE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR THOSE **NOT** STAYING IN NBS HOUSING OR TIMESHARES OR OWNER HOUSING TO PURCHASE A BRECK35 PASS AT A HIGHER RATE?

There is a slight chance that we might be able to offer some Breck35 passes at a higher price to those not in NBS housing or timeshares or owners of homes, **however, the NBS will not know until after the late registration deadline (November 30, 2007)**. It will be based on whether we satisfy our contract obligation for housing and registration. Trip leaders will be notified if any become available.

WILL THERE BE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR PARTICIPANTS **NOT** STAYING IN NBS HOUSING OR TIMESHARES OR OWNER HOUSING TO PURCHASE TICKETS SEPARATELY FOR ENTRY INTO INDIVIDUAL NBS EVENING OR NIGHTTIME EVENTS?

WHAT IS THE REGISTRATION CANCELLATION POLICY?

Registration is non-refundable. Registration is Transferable *provided* the registration is transferred for the same type of Registration. Individuals will be allowed to change from a Non-Skier Registration to a Skier Registration Type, but you will be required to pay the amount of Registration due during the time period in which the change was made. For example, if you purchase a non-skier registration on September 15th (early registration time period) and the individual subsequently wants to change to a Skier Registration on October 15th (Regular registration time period), **the individual would have to pay the Skier Regular Registration Price.**

ANY PARTNER PROGRAM DISCOUNTS?

There are NO Partner Program discount prices for registration for AM/CC 2008.
